1. Introduction

2. Information We Collect

We may collect the following categories of personal information:

2.1 Information You Provide

- Name
- Email address
- Billing information (processed securely via third-party payment providers)

- Any information provided in customer service inquiries

2.2 Automatically Collected Information

- IP address
- Device type
- Browser type
- Usage statistics and analytics
- Cookies and tracking technologies (see Section 11)

2.3 Subscription/Account Information

If you enroll in memberships or subscriptions, we may collect:

- Account activity and preferences
- Download history
- Subscription status and renewal settings

3. How We Use Personal Information

We use personal data for the following purposes:

- Processing digital product purchases
- Account creation and subscription management

- Providing customer support
- Sending transactional or administrative emails
- Fraud prevention and security
- Compliance with legal obligations
- Website performance optimization
- Analytics to improve our services

We do **not** use your information for automated decision-making that produces legal or similarly significant effects.

4. Legal Bases for Processing (GDPR)

For users located in the EU/EEA, we process personal data based on:

- Contract performance (e.g., fulfilling purchases)
- Legitimate interests (e.g., preventing fraud, improving services)
- Legal obligations
- Consent (where required for marketing or optional cookies)

5. CCPA Notice for California Users

California residents have the right to:

- Know what categories of personal information we collect
- Request access to or deletion of personal information
- Opt out of the sale or sharing of personal data
- Not be discriminated against for exercising their rights
